RULES AND REGULATIONS OF PONGAL COMPETITIONS

Rangoli:

1. Traditional ways (Pongal Theme) of Rangoli will only be entertained.
2. The participants will be given 45 minutes for drawing Rangoli. No extra time will be given in any case.
3. The participants have to bring their own material i.e, colours, flowers, green leaves paddy skin, salt, rice or any other traditional material required to decorate. (Only White Chalk powder will be provided)
4. A group should not have more than two participants.
5. Judging will be based on the Overall presentation, Relevance to theme, Creativity in Rangoli art and Color combination

Folk Dance: (Group)

1. Minimum 5 to maximum 10 participants are allowed per team. The team may consist of boys or girls or both.
2. The dance can be either primitive or a folk dance (Indian Style) but not a classical one.
3. Vulgar songs will not be entertained at any cost.
4. The duration of dance should not be more than 6 minutes.
5. The judge's decision will be final.

Folk Singing: (Solo)

1. Participants need to select the songs from the genre of rural communities.
2. Musical instruments and track playing is not allowed while singing.
3. The duration of song should not be more than 5 minutes.
4. The judge's decision is to be final.

Traditional Fashion Show:

1. Traditional wear of fashion will only be entertained
2. Only Individual participation is encouraged, not as group.
3. Time for each participant is 5 minutes including both setup and performance.
4. The participants are fully responsible for their own costumes and properties.
5. The participants are expected to submit their audio (theme music/sounds) in advance by providing pen drive.
6. Questions will be asked on the theme and significance of the costume selected by the participant
7. Deviation of themes in forms like vulgarity are strictly prohibited.
8. Judging will be based on the Theme, Costumes and Appearance, Walking stance
